RIGHT TO INFORMATION

Statutory Declaration under Sec-4(1)(B) of RTI ACT 2005

The Right to Information Act 2005 was passed by the Parliament on 15th June 2005. The Act mandates that organizations defined as "Public Authorities" are obliged to provide information to the public and create necessary arrangements in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has been declared a "Public Authority" under the Act. Implementation of 'The Right to Information Act, 2005' The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June 2005. This Act provides for the right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled, or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act.

In pursuance of the Act, an Officer has been designated as Public Information Officer (PIO) and he/she shall perform the duties and responsibilities as engaged under the act. Necessary steps for the implementation of various provisions include proactive disclosure of certain information. Such information shall be made available to the public at large through the website.
